Captain Rodney D. Weicht was the Assistant Warden of the Washington County Detention Center and a twenty-eight year member of the Sheriff's Office. His death on October 18, 2011 was and will remain a tragic loss to the people who love him, the citizens he served, and his profession.

Rodney Weicht began his career with the Washington County Detention Center in June of 1983. He achieved many honors and distinctions throughout his service, and he worked diligently to be both a resource and a leader within his profession. He was an Associate Instructor through the Maryland Police and Correctional Training Commission, a member of the Washington County Commissioner's Safety Committee, a Duly Authorized Inspector for the Maryland Commission on Correctional Standards, a member of the Maryland Correctional Administrators Association, and an American Correctional Association member. Rodney graduated from both the Leadership Challenge Program and the MPCTC Executive Development Institute.

Rodney is survived by his wife, Linda, who is also a member of our agency, and two children: son Doug, and daughter Brittany.
